5. RIZWAN NEWS APPEAL

To inform the Committee of the outcome of the appeal from the sub-committee's decision to the Magistrates Court.

On 15 May 2012 a licensing sub-committee heard an application by Staffordshire County Council Trading Standards to review the premises licence for Rizwan News, 123 Knutton Lane. The application set out a number of areas of concern relating to test purchase failures and the sale of alcohol and tobacco to minors.

The appeal was heard before the Magistrates sitting at Fenton Magistrates Court on 18 July 2012 who dismissed the appeal.
