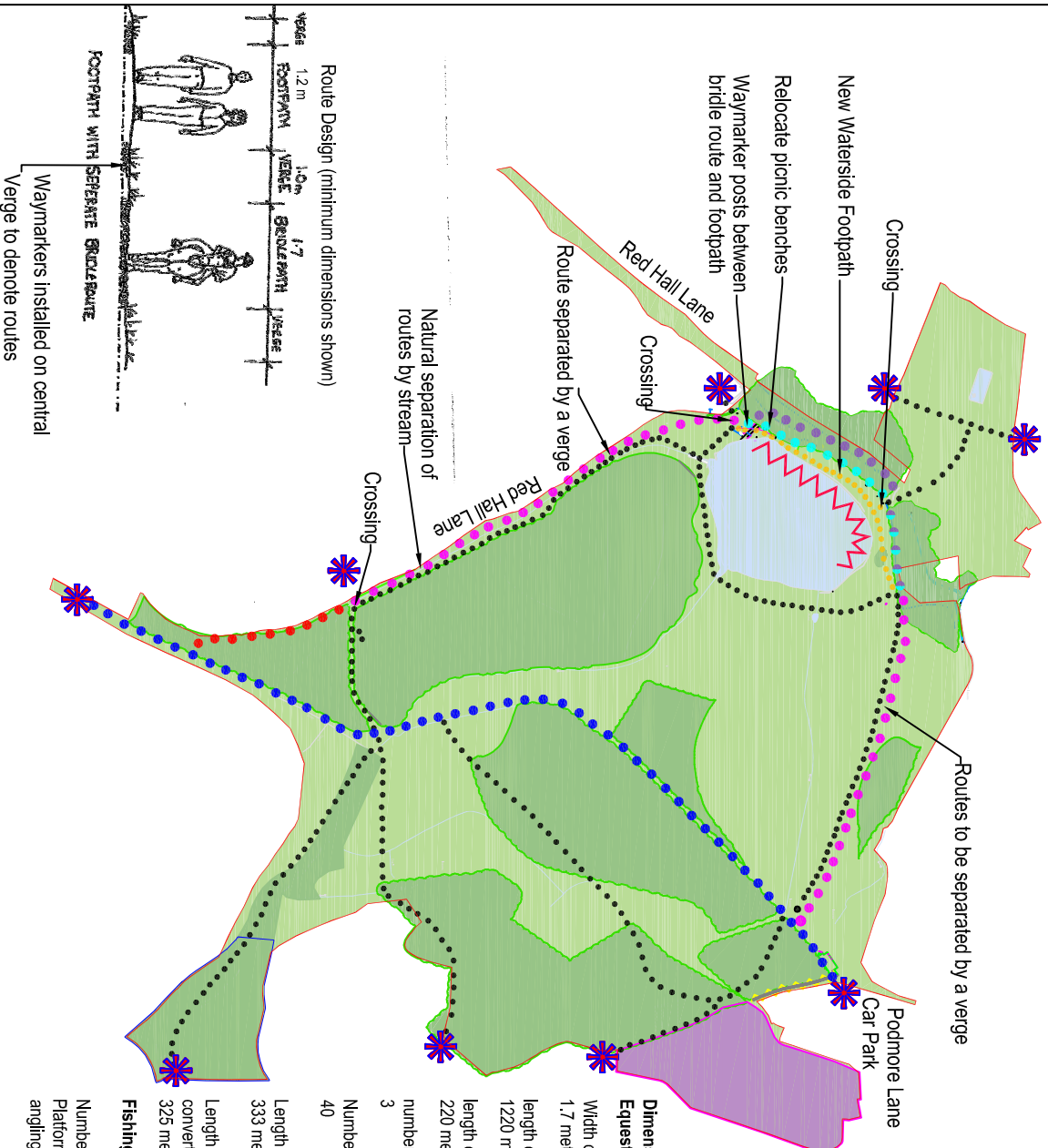
Design for Fishing Platform

The design, number required, and locations of proposed fishing platforms is to be drawn up in conjunction with members of local fishing clubs.

A platform is to be constructed to the standards recommended by the British Disabled Angling Association.

The need for additional floating baskets is to be discussed with fishing clubs.

Use of the pool for fishing will be managed by an angling club and subject to a robust agreement with anglers to control issues such as access, fish stocking and marginal habitat management.
