- 1.1 At the time of writing (27/11/15), 37 applications have been received via 11 Locally Based Bodies at a total of £25,111.01.
- 1.2 19 applications have received the full amount applied for, 11 received a grant below the applied amount, 5 received no grant, and 1 has been deferred. Grants totalling £14,305.84 have been issued.

2. <u>Issues</u>

2.1 To date, £28,694.16 of the budget remains unspent – 67% of the budget. 4 of the LBBs have spent none of their allocation.

2.2 A grant of £800.00 to Keele Parish Council approved at the September 2015 Panel meeting has been subsequently been refused by the applicant.
