

## **Brief for Scrutiny**

<b>Topic to be scrutinised</b> GP Referral to Jubilee 2 for rehabilitation and health and well being activities
<b>Questions to be addressed</b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. What proportion of members and regular users have been referred to Jubilee 2 fitness programmes by GPs and/or hospital referrals?</li><li>2. What provisions are in place to ensure the needs of these members are fully met and that programmes are suitable for their needs?</li><li>3. What proportion of members are carers supporting others?</li><li>4. Are staff suitably trained to deliver services to patients with additional health requirements?</li><li>5. Given closures of NHS services and wards what funding arrangements are in place to support the additional burden to provide fully trained staff and services to support this group of users?</li><li>6. How effective are the membership feedback mechanisms currently in place and the open collaboration of members with management?</li></ol>
<b>Outcome</b> <p>An overview of the health and well-being status of members and an understanding of any sub-groups that may require additional provision.</p> <p>Explore the potential for additional programmes/series of talks etc. that would support members.</p> <p>Highlight any further training requirements for staff if needed.</p> <p>If there are a significant number of referrals from NHS services a clear outline of the cost implications and funding streams.</p> <p>Ensure that members have a strong relationship with management and that there is a collaborative working arrangement.</p>
<b>Background materials</b> <p>Vision statement for Jubilee Data for membership and classes provided</p>
<b>Evidence and witnesses</b> <p>Members, staff and management interviews/questionnaires Discussion with GP and/or NHS services making referrals</p>

<p><b>Method of scrutiny</b></p> <p>Interviews/focus groups questionnaires analysis of relevant data</p>
<p><b>Timetable</b></p> <p>Completion by June 2017</p>
<p><b>Constraints</b></p> <p>Some awareness of</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- data protection issues</li><li>- safe-guarding if dealing with vulnerable adults in interview settings</li><li>- confidentiality for members providing disclosure of personal information</li><li>- some of this scrutiny touches on an area where there may have been formal complaints so this should be taking into account.</li></ul>
