

PARKING RESTRICTIONS – STUBBS GATE

Purpose of the Report

To consider the request from Staffordshire County Council for introduction of waiting restrictions in Stubbs Gate.

Recommendation

That the scheme for additional waiting restrictions in Stubbs Gate as shown on the accompanying plan be supported.

1. Background

- 1.1 Local residents made representations to Ward Members regarding the indiscriminate parking on Stubbs Gate between the junction with Brook Land and Refinery Street.
- 1.2 The request was added to the list of parking related issues.

2. Issues

- 2.1 This issue has been prioritised to be invested this financial year by the Joint Parking Committee (JPC)
- 2.2 The County Council have investigated the problem and have proposed that a “No Parking at Any Time” restriction be introduced along Stubbs Gate, from its junction with Brook Lane to Refinery Street as indicated on the attached plan.

3. Proposal

- 3.1 To reduce the congestion due to parked vehicles, the introduction of the additional waiting restriction be supported.
