10/691/FUL	Single storey side extension to form sun room. Brooklands, Common Lane, Betley. Mr D Hales.	No comments.
10/692/FUL	Ground floor rear extensions and alterations. Wade Centre, The Avenue, Kidsgrove. St Thomas PCC.	The Working Party was disappointed with the quality of the design for the proposed extensions to this historic building but accepted that its previous extensions had already compromised the building.
10/707/ADV	Externally illuminated fascia signs and applied lettering to shop front and door. 19 High Street, Newcastle. Forster Dean Ltd.	Members objected to the proposed signage as it was felt to be obtrusive. The applicant should retain the signage in the existing fascia panel. The Council's Conservation Officer would negotiate with the applicant to discuss a better, more appropriate scheme.
10/710/LBC & 10/711/FUL	Single storey extension to form garden room (revision to previously approved scheme ref 10/458/LBC & 10/459/FUL). Ashley Farm, School Lane, Ashley. Dr D J West.	The Conservation Advisory Working Party objected to this proposal as it was felt to be harmful to the Listed Building.
10/714/FUL	Erection of a 20kw 27m (max height to the blade tip) wind turbine. Fields Farm, Wharmadine Lane, Ashley. Mr Richard Furnival.	The Working Party felt that the turbine may be visible from Maer Conservation Area and that it may have an adverse impact on the views into and from the Conservation Area.
