The Conservation Advisory Working Party had strong concerns regarding this application. The turbines would have an adverse impact upon historic views from the listed buildings and their setting. In that respect, the turbines would also harm the character and appearance of the registered park, adding a new element and resulting in a change to the wider landscaping setting of the parkland and beyond.
