374. * MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETINGS

375. * DECLARATIONS OF INTERESTS

Mr Chatterton declared an interest in planning application 09/484/COU.

376. * PLANNING APPLICATIONS

Resolved:- (a) That the decisions on applications previously considered by this Working Party be received subject to the following comments:-

(i) 09/317/FUL Members noted the decision to grant planning permission for this extension but re-affirmed their earlier comments regarding the design of the proposed windows that differed from the overall fenestration of the building.

Having regard to the strong objections previously voiced by the Working Party, Members expressed disappointment that retrospective planning permission had been granted for the boundary wall. Concern was also expressed at what appeared to be inconsistent advice from the Highway Authority on the use of Highway land for private development.

380. * ENGLISH HERITAGE PARTNERSHIP SCHEME IN NEWCASTLE TOWN CENTRE PARTNERSHIP SCHEME

It was reported that Cabinet, at its meeting on 9 September 2009 had approved £150,000 capital funding over 3 years for the above scheme and that a detailed application for match funding from English Heritage would now be submitted. The area proposed for the partnership Scheme was Bridge Street, Church Street, High Street (upper end) and the Ironmarket (up to and including Market Lane) although the precise area had still to be defined.
