A report was submitted seeking approval to the adoption of a scheme for the Council to receive petitions which had to be in place by 16 June 2010.

This was a requirement of the Local Democracy, Economic Development and Construction Act 2009 Commencement Order No.3.

In addition the Council was also required to have a facility for receiving petitions in electronic form by 15 December 2010.

Details of the scheme were considered and it was indicated that, whilst the scheme set no threshold on the number of signatures required to request the Council to take action so making it responsive to local issues as well as greater issues affecting the whole Borough, it was suggested that a petition of 1000 or more signatures could provide for a debate to be held at the Full Council. In addition a petition of 500 or more signatures would be required to mandate a senior officer to give evidence at a public meeting of an Overview & Scrutiny Committee.

**Resolved:-** (a) That the Petitions Scheme as suggested be agreed and incorporated within the Council's Constitution.

(b) That the Overview & Scrutiny Co-ordinating Committee review the proposed thresholds on the number of signatures required to trigger the necessary action.
