Issues

Representations had been submitted by Staffordshire Police and Environmental Health.

Decision

The Sub-Committee having taken into account the local authority's Licensing Policy and also the guidance issued under the Act, and having also considered the relevant representations and having listened to the arguments and subject to conditions referred to, the Sub-Committee granted a variation of licence for the premises on the following basis:-

The licensable activities of live music, recorded music, provision for facilities for dancing, late night refreshment, supply of alcohol for the following hours:-

Monday to Sunday 11.00 to 02.00

The hours the premises are to be open to the public are as follows:-

Monday to Sunday until 02.30

with an additional hour on the days on which BST begins.

Condition

The Sub-Committee have agreed to remove the embedded restrictions apart from those relating to New Year's Eve and the public entertainment conditions. Additional conditions are imposed as identified in the operating schedule and outlined in Annex B and the additional conditions offered today being:

(1) During university term time on Tuesdays, the premises must operate a free mini bus service to transport customers directly from the premises to Keele University Campus.

- (2) During university term time, Tuesday evening entrance shall be restricted to those persons holding an NUS card as identification.
- (3) On Wednesday, Friday and Saturday evenings, the premises shall operate a taxi marshalling scheme, with advertising and encouragement for customers to participate in this scheme. A member of staff must be easily identifiable to customers for booking this service.
- (4) Customers will not be permitted to multi order drinks at the end of the night.
- (5) On the nights open beyond 1.00am, no entry will be permitted after 1.00am.
- (6) When sporting events of national/international importance are to be screened, the Police will be given 7 days notice. For these events, plastic pint containers will be used and no glass bottles will be provided.
- (7) To offer suitable refreshment all night.
- (8) To maintain current working drugs policy.
