170. \* **BOOZEWISE, 61 HIGH STREET, NEWCHAPEL – APPLICATION FOR VARIATION TO PREMISES LICENCE**

**Issues**

Representations had been received from Staffordshire Police and a number of interested parties residing in the vicinity of the premises on the basis that to grant the application would undermine the prevention of crime and disorder, public nuisance and protection of children from harm Licensing Objectives.

**Decision**

The Sub-Committee having considered the licensing objectives and having listened to the representations and arguments were concerned that to increase the hours for the supply of alcohol from 18.00 to 21.00 would exacerbate the crime and disorder and public nuisance already prevalent within the vicinity of the premises, which appeared to decrease when the premises was not open in the evening.

In view of the above, the Sub-Committee were disposed to refuse the application.
