lssues

Representations had been received from interested parties concerning the prevention of Public Nuisance.

Decision

Having taken into account the Licensing Act 2003, the Council's Statement of Licensing Policy and the Guidance issued under Section 182 of the Act, and the fact that both neither the Environment Health Officers, the Police, the Fire Brigade nor the Planning Officers have objected.

Consideration was given to relevant representations, the oral representations and the Licensing Objectives. The Committee were satisfied that to grant a variation of hours would not promote the prevention of public nuisance.

The Committee approved the variation for provision of regulated entertainment, namely Live Music as follows:-

Hours When Live Music Shall Be Permitted

Monday to Saturday inc	11.00am until 10.30pm
Sunday	Noon until 10.00pm
Christmas Eve inc Sunday	11.00am until 10.30pm
New Years Eve inc Sunday	11.00am until 00.30am on the following day

The conditions which Committee were disposed to impose in addition to any Mandatory and Embedded Conditions are as follows:-

The Prevention of Crime and Disorder

- (a) The premises licence holder shall be a member of the Kidsgrove Pub Watch Scheme. The designated premises supervisor shall abide by any rules or resolutions passed by the said Pub Watch Scheme.
- (b) Alcoholic beverages shall not be served in bottle containers.

Public Safety

(a) A complete no-smoking policy shall operate throughout the internal area of the premises.

The Prevention of Public Nuisance

- (a) All windows at the premises shall be double-glazed.
- (b) No music other than unamplified music shall be played at the premises.
- (c) Noise from regulated entertainment shall be inaudible at the boundary of the nearest noise sensitive premises.
- (d) No consumption of liquid refreshments shall be permitted outside the front of the premises after 10.00pm.
- (e) Musical performances shall be carried out as far away as possible from any open windows at the front of the property.
