Issues

Representations had been received from Staffordshire Police. Following negotiations between the parties, additional conditions to be attached to a Licence had been agreed. Representations received from an interested party and Planning and Regeneration, however, remained outstanding.

Decision

The Committee having taken into account, the Licensing Act; the Council's Statement of Licensing Policy; the guidance under Section 182; the written representations; the oral representation from Regeneration and Planning, Mr Turner and the withdrawal of Staffordshire Police's representation subject to the applicant's revised application with additional conditions, decided to grant the revised application, being the increase in the area of the premises to include the roof terrace, the removal of the condition headed special hours condition on page 5 of the current Premises Licence with the imposition of additional conditions as detailed below with no amendment to licensable hours.

Additional Conditions

- (1) No glassware including glass bottles to be taken onto the roof terrace area by customers and/or Brassington's staff after 2300 hours on all days. All vessels thereafter to be polycarbonate.
- (2) CCTV camera will be placed in order to provide coverage of all the toilet corridor area and also the open roof terrace. The CCTV will have a facility for recording and will record during any time that the public have access. Recordings will be stored for a minimum of 31 days and copies will be made available upon the request of the Police or other relevant authorities.

- (3) A minimum of one door supervisor to be in place to provide supervision of the roof terrace and the toilet area at any time when the toilets and/or roof terrace are being used by Brassington's customers.
- (4) Entertainment on the roof terrace will consist of background incidental music at low ambient levels and will be controlled by a separate amplified to those in the main bar areas. There will be no bass amplification. Live entertainment permitted will be solo instrumentalists and duo acts only. There will be no live bands.
