Issues

It was reported that representations had been received from Staffordshire Police who were represented at the meeting.

Decision

The Sub-Committee having taken into account the Licensing Act 2003, the Council's Statement of Licensing Policy, in particular Section 5 (Saturation Policy), the Guidance issued under the Act, the Police objections and the fact that the premises are currently operating, selling cold food. The Committee resolved to approve the application as follows:-

Sunday, Monday, Tuesday, Thursday – 08.00 – 22.00
(No Premises Licence being required for these times)

Wednesday, Friday, Saturday – 08.00 – 02.00

The conditions imposed by Committee in addition to the mandatory conditions are as follows:-

The Prevention of Crime and Disorder

- (a) There shall be a CCTV system installed at the premises.
- (b) The CCTV system shall record at all times during the provision of licensable activity.
- (c) The CCTV shall be maintained and fully operational during the hours of licensable activity.
- (d) The CCTV system shall record images that cover the licensable area and any other locations as agreed in writing with Staffordshire Police Service.
- (e) Such recordings shall be available for inspection by authorised officers of Staffordshire Police Service and Newcastle-under-Lyme Borough Council.

The Prevention of Public Nuisance

- (a) A member of staff shall each day carry out litter collection of all litter on all roads and public places within 100 metres of the premises.
- (b) The premises shall provide two litter bins to the specification of Newcastle-under-Lyme Borough Council and in locations chosen by Newcastle-under-Lyme Borough Council.

The Protection of Children From Harm

- (a) No children under the age of 14 unaccompanied by an adult shall be present at the premises after 9.00pm.

Conditions Imposed at Hearing

- (a) There must be one member of staff present on the premises during the hours of Licensable activities who has received training in door supervision techniques.
- (b) The premises must participate in the “Night Net” radio scheme or its equivalent.
