74. * **SEASONS, 17 LONDON ROAD – APPLICATION FOR PREMISES LICENCE**

Issues

Representations had been received from Staffordshire Police and the Planning Authority on the basis that to grant the application would undermine the prevention of crime and disorder, public nuisance and public safety Licensing Objectives.

Decision

The Sub-Committee having considered the licensing objectives and having listened to the representations and arguments were persuaded that to grant the application at the present time would fail to promote the licensing objectives. The Sub-Committee were concerned that the granting of a licence would exacerbate the nuisance and disorder currently taking place within the vicinity of the premises in an area which is predominantly residential.

In view of the above and due to the fact that the applicant had failed to show that the operation of the premises would not add to the cumulative impact already being experienced, the Sub-Committee were disposed to refuse the application.
