### 302. \* SUBWAY, LIVERPOOL ROAD, NEWCASTLE

#### Issues

Representations had been received from Interested Parties in the locality concerning the Prevention of Public Nuisance. Community Services (Planning) also drew the Sub-Committee's attention that planning permission for use of the premises had not yet been granted.

#### Decision

The Sub-Committee considered the relevant licensing objectives and also the relevant representations and were persuaded that to grant a Licence for the provision of late night refreshment for the hours applied for would offend the licensing objective in relation to public nuisance. The Sub-Committee were however prepared to grant a licence for the premises on the following basis:

The provision of late night refreshment from Monday to Sunday inclusive 8am until 12 midnight.

The conditions which the Sub-Committee were disposed to impose in addition to those specified in Appendix 'D' of the agenda were:-

- (1) Permanent clear and legible notices to be displayed outside the premises indicating that car parking is for patrons only.
- (2) The applicant to use his best endeavours to introduce a one way system for patrons' vehicles entering the premises from the A34 and exiting on Lower Milehouse Lane.
- (3) That children under the age of 14 years shall not be served after 10pm unless supervised by an adult.

**OPERATING SCHEDULE**

**(1) The Prevention of Crime and Disorder**

CCTV shall be provided at the premises.

The CCTV shall be maintained in effective working order and shall be operating during the provision of licensable activities and all tapes/recordings shall be kept for a minimum of 31 days.

**(2) Public Safety**

Staff shall be trained in all aspects of Health and Safety Legislation.

**(3) Protection of Children From Harm**

No vending machines or facilities providing hot beverages shall be available within the public/seating area.
