Issues

Representations had been received from a number of interested parties residing in the vicinity of the premises objecting to the application on the basis of the crime and disorder, and public nuisance licensing objectives.

A similar number of representations had also been received in support of the application.

Resolved

That having considered the relevant licensing objectives, the representations and the conditions offered by the applicant, the Sub Committee agreed that a licence to cover hours in excess of those granted on the previous premises licence would not promote the licensing objectives.

Therefore, subject to the mandatory conditions, the conditions consistent with those specified in the applicants operating schedule and those set out below, the Sub Committee were prepared to grant a licence for the premises:~

Hours of licensable activities:

Monday	10.00 – 23.30
Tuesday	10.00 – 23.30
Wednesday	10.00 – 23.30
Thursday	10.00 – 23.30
Friday	10.00 – 00.30
Saturday	10.00 – 00.30
Sunday	12.00 – 23.30

• The premises be closed to the public thirty minutes after the cessation of the supply of alcohol.

• The proposed opening hours, as set out in the report, relating to special occasions were approved.

Additional Conditions:

- 1. That noise from regulated entertainment should be inaudible at the boundary of the nearest noise sensitive premises.
- 2. That permanent, clear and legible notices asking customers to respect the needs of local residents and to leave quietly, be displayed at all exits used by customers.
- 3. That regulated entertainment be provided by no more that a trio at any time.
- 4. That a no entry policy be adopted to commence 30 minutes before the terminal hour for the provision of alcohol.

That no films be shown on the premises.
