Issues

Representations had been received concerning the Prevention of Public Nuisance.

Resolved

The Sub-Committee having considered the relevant licensing objectives and also the relevant representation(s) were persuaded that to grant the variation subject to the agreed conditions would not offend the relevant licensing objectives. Therefore subject to the additional conditions set out below, the Sub-Committee were prepared to grant a variation of the license for the premises.

Additional Conditions

- (i) After 23.00 there shall be no consumption of alcohol or licensable activities conducted in the outside area. Patrons will only be allowed to use the area for the purpose of smoking.
- (ii) The management team of the pub shall ensure that the outside area of the premises are only used for the purpose of smoking after 23.00.
- (iii) After 23.20 hours, there shall be a maximum capacity of 10 persons in the beer garden at any one time.
- (iv) The beer garden shall not be used after 00.30 hours.
- (v) Noise from regulated entertainment shall be inaudible at the boundary of the nearest noise sensitive premises.
- (vi) Lighting will be provided to ensure that the outside areas used in the hours of darkness are adequately lit.
- (vii) Signs will be displayed in the outside area asking customers to respect our neighbours and keep noise reduced.

- (viii) Regular checks of the outside area will be made by the outlet team. Any customers involved in excessive loud behaviour will ask to desist and customers persisting with such behaviour will be removed from the outside area.
- (ix) Checks to be made of the outside areas to ensure there is no light spillage over neighbouring premises.
