

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

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# Agenda Item 14a

## HEADING Public Protection Committee Arrangements

Submitted by: Head of Environmental Health

Portfolio: Finance & Resources

Ward(s) affected: All

## Purpose of the Report

To consider proposals relating to the creation of a Licensing and Public Protection Committee and a Public Protection Sub-Committee and to review the arrangements for these-committees and associated delegations.

## **Recommendations**

That a Licensing and Public Protection Committee and a Public Protection Sub-Committee be created for the purpose set out in the report and that the detailed delegations referred to be approved.

## <u>Reasons</u>

Committee business particularly in respect of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976 and the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 has increased significantly (there being 12 meetings during the last financial year compared to the scheduled number which has, typically, been up to 6 meetings per year) and therefore a review of arrangements has been undertaken to determine whether these matters can be dealt with more effectively by a sub-committee with specific delegated responsibilities. Such changes would then facilitate Licensing and Public Protection combining.

#### 1. Background

- 1.1 The Council's Public Protection Committee has many delegated functions including the review of hackney carriage and private hire drivers, vehicles and operators which are not in full compliance with the Council's current 'Taxi and Private Hire Policy 2015'.
- 1.2 In 2014, the LGA Peer Review looked at the Council's committee arrangements. One recommendation was that Public Protection Committee and Licensing Committee should be amalgamated. There are however some distinct legal difference between the two committees, so although not amalgamated there was a desire that these meetings would be held sequentially. Unfortunately due to the amount of business this has not been feasible.
- 1.3 Members will note that the Licensing Committee is supported by a Licensing Sub-Committee; this arrangement is detailed in the Licensing Act 2003 and has been operational in that format since 2005.
- 1.4 In view of the above a review of the current arrangements has therefore been undertaken.

## 2. <u>Issues</u>

2.1 The business for Public Protection Committee has increased significantly in the past couple of years. Meetings are held approximately every 4-6 weeks, with very full agendas and the meetings regularly ending between 9pm and 10pm.

- 2.2 A significant part of the committee business is the determination of Hackney Carriage and Private Hire Driver and Vehicle Licenses.
- 2.3 Some feedback has been received from applicants regarding the wait time at committee and also that it is very daunting presenting to a full councillor committee.
- 2.4 Comments have also been received from some Committee members regarding the length of the agenda and the duration of meetings.

## 3. **Options Considered**

- 3.1 There are a number of options that could be considered including:
  - 3.1.1 OPTION ONE Make no changes and retain the existing Public Protection and Licensing committee arrangements.
  - 3.1.2 OPTION TWO Make no changes to the Public Protection committee but increase the frequency of meetings.
  - 3.1.3 OPTION THREE Change the committee arrangements to combine Licensing and Public Protection committees.

## 4. Proposal

- 4.1 It is your officer's recommendation that Option 3 is the preferred arrangement. In summary the proposed changes would include:
  - 4.1.1 Creation of a Licensing and Public Protection Committee (operating in two separate parts for Licensing and Public Protection Matters)
  - 4.1.2 Creation of a Public Protection Sub-Committee with powers to deal with taxi driver, vehicle and operator licenses and issues.
  - 4.1.3 Amendment to Public Protection Committee's scheme of delegation to allow for the delegation of powers to the Public Protection Sub-Committee and powers to determine prosecutions to officers.
  - 4.1.4 Creation and updated terms of reference and procedure for the committees.
- 4.2 Should members agree to this proposal the following specific more detailed arrangements are detailed below.

#### 4.3 Constitution/Terms of Reference:

- 4.3.1 The Council's Constitution and terms of reference for the Committees would require amendment to take into account the creation of a combined Licensing and Public Protection Committee and a Public Protection sub-committee The Terms of reference for a Licensing and Public Protection Committee have been updated and are attached at Appendix A.
- 4.3.2 Terms of reference for the Public Protection Sub-Committee are attached at Appendix B.

#### 4.4 Scheme of delegation:

4.4.1 The Council's scheme of delegation would require amendment to take into account the creation of a Public Protection sub-committee and specifically detail what matters

can be dealt with; this would include the consideration of applications for a new licence, a renewal licence or enforcement of a licence where an officer has determined these applications are not in compliance with the Council's Policy.

**4.5** The scheme of delegation for the Public Protection committee will also require amendment to take into account the functions that are delegated to it from the wider Environmental Health Service as it will be meeting less frequently. It is therefore proposed to change the scheme of delegation for the approval of prosecution proceedings to Executive Director Regeneration & Development and Head of Environmental Health Services. These amendments are detailed in appendix C.

## 4.6 Meeting arrangements:

- 4.6.1 It is proposed that the sub-committee arrangements are as follows:
  - a. Meeting Members 3 to 5 Councillors
  - b. Meeting Quorums 3
  - c. Meeting Frequency as required
  - d. Meeting notification and publication of papers 5 working days prior
  - e. Meeting Times During working day (9am to 5pm)

## 4.7 Procedures:

- 4.7.1 The 'procedure to be followed by Public Protection Committee in determining Hackney Carriage and Private Hire Licences' (as published in the front of every agenda) will be amended in title from Public Protection Committee will be replaced by Public Protection & Sub-Committee.
- 4.7.2 The procedure will also be amended at bullet point 4 from 14 days to 5 days so that the Sub-Committee can be more responsive to applications.
- 4.7.3 The amended document is attached as Appendix D.

## 5. **Reasons for Preferred Solution**

- 5.1 To enable Committee to determine applications in the most efficient, effective and practical manner.
- 5.2 To ensure that the Council continues to provide safe transport for those wishing to use Private Hire and Hackney Carriage vehicles.

## 6. Outcomes Linked to Sustainable Community Strategy and Corporate Priorities

- 6.1 In line with the Council's objectives
  - Promoting a cleaner, safer and sustainable Borough
  - Promoting a Borough of Opportunity

## 7. Legal and Statutory Implications

7.1 The Local Government Act 1972, section 101 allows the Council to arrange for a Committee, Sub-Committee or an officer or another local authority to carry out its powers and duties.

## 8. Equality Impact Assessment

8.1 The meetings will be undertaken to accord with the Human Rights Act 1998, Article 6(1) guarantees an applicant a fair hearing and Article 14 guarantees no discrimination.

## 9. Financial and Resource Implications

- 9.1 There will be no direct financial costs associated with the proposals. The proposals should however result in savings through not having to call as many full committee meetings.
- 9.2 There will be resource implication including Member participation in the sub-committees and officer support from Environmental Health, Legal and Democratic services. Although there may be an increase in resource during the day time period when the sub-committee meetings are held there should also be a reduction in the number and duration of full Public Protection committees during the evening. This net reduction will then enable the LGA Peer review's recommendation for Licensing and Public Protection committees to be combined.

## Appendix A

Licensing & Public Protection Committee – Proposed Terms of Reference

The Licensing & Public Protection Committee will be held in two parts, the first part as a Licensing Committee and the second part as a Public Protection Committee.

Licensing:

To deal with all matters under the Licensing Act 2003 and Gambling Act 2005 delegated from Full Council including:

1. With the exception of the Councils Licensing policy statements under the Licensing Act 2003 and Gambling Act 2005 (upon which it will advise), the licensing committee shall from time to time determine its policy relating to licensing matters after it has consulted with such parties as the law may require and/or whom it considers to be appropriate and it shall cause that policy to be published.

2. The Licensing Committee may, from time to time, establish conditions to the extent permitted by the law governing the administration of licensing matters, the conduct and behaviour of licence holders and for technical requirements and specifications, licensed premises and vehicles.

3. The Committee shall have delegated powers to consider all applications for licenses or permissions issued on behalf of the Council, including attaching conditions thereto, to consider and determine all applications for review, continuation, transfer, variation, renewal, suspension, closure orders, forfeiture or revocation of all licenses and permissions issued by or on behalf of the Council, including attaching conditions thereto and to consider appeals against terminations or tenancy at will.

4. The Committee shall, from time to time, receive reports on the cultural, economic and tourism impact of its work and it shall from time to time, as required by law or as it considers appropriate, make reports of its activity to Cabinet, overview and scrutiny committee and Planning Committee.

5. The committee may from time to time and to the extent permitted by the law, delegate any of its functions in paragraph 3 above to a body comprising of not less than 3 elected members drawn from members of the committee, to be known as a licensing panel (sub-committee), a quorum for such panel to being three members. The committee may establish more than one panel and membership of the panel(s) may be rotated as necessary amongst members of the Committee.

6. The committee may from time to time and to the extent permitted by the law, delegate any of its functions in paragraph 3 above, to be discharged by an Executive Director. The Executive Director may delegate such powers, duties, responsibilities and functions as he considers appropriate, and to the extent permitted by the law, to officers of the Council.

Public Protection Committee:

The Public Protection Committee will have the following roles and functions:

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- a. To exercise the powers and duties of the Council in relation to licensing and registration functions.
- b. To exercise and perform the powers and duties of the Council in relation to the following matters:
- (1) Food Safety and Control

To ensure that all food prepared, manufactured, processed and sold within the Borough is produced in safe and hygienic conditions.

## (2) Occupational Health and Safety

To ensure that persons working in premises which fall within the area of responsibility of the Borough Council, do so in a safe and healthy environment.

(3) Infectious Disease Control

To control and prevent the spread of specified infectious diseases.

(4) <u>Water Supply</u>

To ensure that all residents in the Borough are provided with a constant supply of wholesome and potable water.

(5) Swimming Baths

To monitor and control the quality of bathing water.

(6) <u>Health Education and Promotion</u>

To promote awareness of health matters to residents of the Borough.

(7) Animal Welfare

To ensure that, where animals are bred, boarded, sold or used in any other way, they are cared for in a humane manner.

(8) <u>Pest Control</u>

To control infestations within the Borough by rats and mice, to remedy the existence of verminous premises, persons or articles, and to control insect pests of public health significance in premises.

(9) Sunday Trading

To implement the Sunday Trading Act 1994.

## (10) <u>Atmospheric Pollution Control</u>

To protect and improve local air quality management including statutory nuisances and the pollution prevention control regime and Local Air Quality monitoring and management.

(11) <u>Nuisance</u>

To protect the local environment by the control of public and statutory nuisances including noise sources and the promotion of awareness of the need to create or allow Nuisance including excessive noise.

(12) Anti-Social Behaviour (ASB)

To control anti-social behaviour and to determine Public Spaces Protection Orders.

(13) <u>Control of Dogs</u>

To promote responsible dog ownership within the Borough.

(14) Asbestos Removal

To eliminate environmental hazards associated with asbestos.

(15) <u>Contaminated and Derelict Land (including Landfill Sites)</u>

To ensure that material identified as being present on land in the Borough do not cause a hazard to health or nuisance to neighbouring properties and that any development provides a safe and healthy environment for occupation and use; and to promote the reclamation of derelict land.

(16) Pollution Monitoring

To identify the presence of pollutants within the environment both generally and in relation to specific sources.

(17) Environmental Impact Assessments

To assess potential environmental impacts from new developments in the Borough.

(18) Environmental Enforcement

To prevent the unauthorised and improper disposal of waste within the Borough and enviro-crime activities.

(19) Housing

To review housing conditions throughout the Borough and initiate action in relation to nuisance disrepair, improvement, clearance and demolition; and to administer renovation grants.

## (20) Camping and Caravan Site

To control camp and caravan sites.

## (21) Licensing and Registration

To exercise powers and duties in relation to all licensing and registration excluding those matters which relate to the Licensing Act 2003 and the Gambling Act 2005 delegated to the Licensing Committee.

To discharge any other function where an officer has decided not to exercise their delegated authority and has referred the matter to the Public Protection Committee for determination.

Terms of reference

## **Public Protection Sub Committee**

The Public Protection Sub Committee will have the following roles and functions:

To exercise the powers and duties of the Council in relation to Hackney Carriage and Private Hire functions in relation to the following matters:

- 1. Hackney Carriage and Private Hire
  - A. To determine an application for:
    - a. a new licence,
    - b. a renewal licence or;
    - c. enforcement of a licence
  - B. To determine an application for a Driver's licence, an operator's licence, or a proprietor's vehicle licence where an officer has determined that these applications are not in compliance with the Council's Policy and has decided not to exercise their delegated authority and referred the matter to the Public Protection Sub Committee.
- 2. To discharge any other function referred by the Public Protection Committee including making representations to the Public Protection Committee in connection with the discharge of its functions.

#### PROCEDURE TO BE FOLLOWED BY PUBLIC PROTECTION AND PUBLIC PROTECTION SUB- COMMITTEE IN DETERMINING HACKNEY CARRIAGE AND PRIVATE HIRE LICENCES

1. The Chairman will open the proceedings by stating the nature of the matter which is to be considered (first application/renewal/suspension/revocation), whether the proceedings concern a vehicle, drivers' or operators' licence (in the case of Private Hire Cars) or a driver's or vehicle licence (in the case of Hackney Carriages) and the name of the applicant or licence holder.

2. The Chairman will introduce him/herself and the members of the committee, the Clerk to the committee and any other officer present.

3. The Chairman will ask the officers to confirm whether or not the formal requirements in respect of the matter to be considered have been complied with. In the case of a proposed suspension or revocation of a licence, refusal to renew or a new licence application, the Chairman will ask the Licensing Officer to confirm whether or not the requisite 5 days' prior notice has been served on the licence holder.

4. If satisfied as to the formal requirements, the matter under consideration will then be outlined by the Licensing Officer.

5. The committee will consider the merits of the application or proposed suspension/revocation and the report of the officers. The committee may ask the officers for clarification of any points in issue.

6. The Chairman will then invite the applicant or licence holder to make any representations. The applicant or licence holder may make his/her representations personally or through a representative, who shall first identify him/herself.

7. The Chairman and other members of the committee may ask the applicant or license holder questions and points of clarification.

8. The applicant or licence holder, his/her representative (if any) and any officer present (with the exception of the Lawyer and the Clerk to the committee) shall withdraw.

9. The members of the committee consider their decision. If any further clarification or information is required form the applicant or licence holder or any officer, all parties will be recalled.

10. All parties will be recalled for the announcement by the Chairman of the committee's decision.

11. The committee's decision will be confirmed in writing by the Proper Officer.

12. At any point in this procedure, the committee may pass a resolution excluding the press and public from the meeting on the basis that, if they were to remain, there may be disclosure of exempt information (information relating to the private or business affairs of a particular person).


