The design should be bolder and have a greater quality and form. The Working Party does not object to the demolition of the buildings at The Hawthorns. In terms of the housing layout, the Working Party thinks the proposal has considered the surroundings of the village and whilst the architecture is 'safe', it is relatively successful. It suggests that the two open spaces should be linked together better to create better pedestrian movement through the site and that the terraces in front of the open space, adjacent to The Hawthorns are a little too formal combined with the large area of parking. Suggests this area is reworked.


