3. Mobile Phones

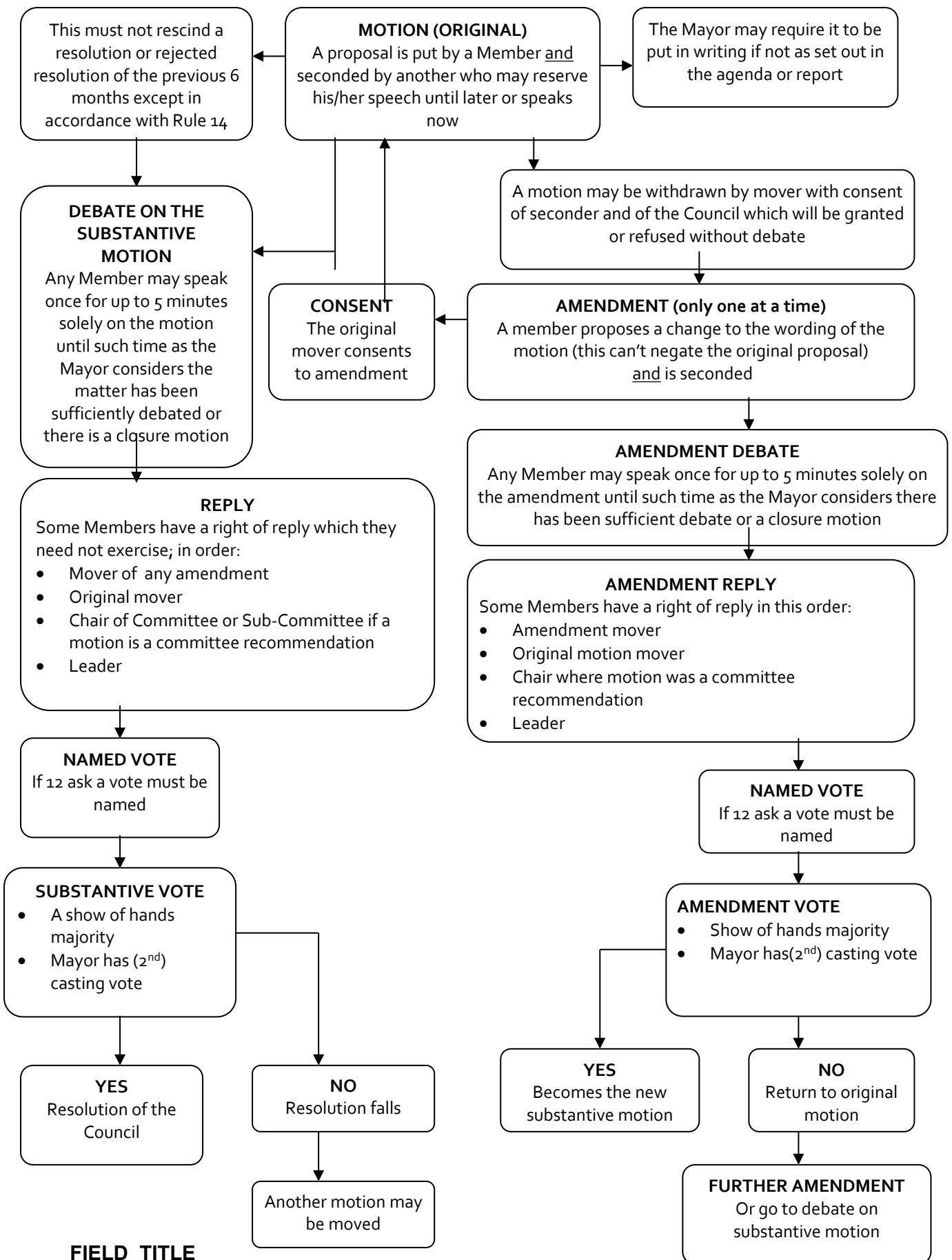
Please switch off all mobile phones before entering the Council Chamber.
