This produces an interesting more useable space to the rear but concerns within the group were raised in relation to the new front window and door, the unsympathetic materials to block up the garage with, the lack of detail at the eaves and potential still for problems with the roof junctions. Some concern was raised in relation to the proposal to remove internal plaster and lack of detail.
