proposal was not in compliance with national policy. No further comments could be provided on the scheme without a detailed heritage statement accompanying the application.

Castle Hill, 2 Nantwich Road, 22/00589/FUL

Concerns were shared by the working party that the replacement windows had resulted in a harmful impact to the quality of the building and the wider Conservation Area. It was largely agreed that the side facing windows were less harmful but that the windows on the front elevation were not appropriate and had resulted in identifiable harm.

The majority of the working party agreed that permission could be given subject to a condition requiring that the front windows either be put back to their original style, or redesigned to a more appropriate arrangement.


