Additional information was requested on what alternative locations had been considered and, in particular, whether a screen could be placed on a building rather than being free-standing.

The Group considered that the statue would be a great asset to the Queens Gardens, the Conservation Area and the Town Centre.

Members were concerned about the loss of the chimney and felt that the structural issues with the chimney could potentially be resolved in another way.
