Purpose of the Report

To appoint Members to committees following the changes in the political proportionality of the Council

<u>Reasons</u>

1.3 Audit & Standards Committee:

- Cllr Barry Panter (Conservative) will cease to be a member of this committee and revert to being a substitute member for this committee;
- Cllr Rebekah Lewis (Labour) will become a member of this committee;

1.4 Economy & Place Scrutiny Committee:

- Cllr Mark Holland (Conservative) will cease to be a member of this committee and revert to being a substitute member for this committee;



- Cllr Robert Moss (Labour) will become a member of this committee

1.5 Planning Committee

- Cllr Wendy Brockie (Labour) will become a member of this committee, taking the current vacant seat;
- 1.6 In addition to the above changes, the election of Cllr Moss and Cllr Lewis require changes to the Appointment to External Bodies.
 - Walleys Quarry Liaison Forum Cllr Moss will attend as the Knutton Councillor, replacing former Cllr Talbot
 - Knutton Quarry Liaison Committee Cllr Moss will attend as the Knutton Councillor, replacing former Councillor Talbot;
 - Community Centre Management Committees, Local Action Partnerships and Resident Associations Cllr Moss and Cllr Lewis will become the Council's nominated representatives for such bodies as exist within their wards.
