

Preserving Newcastle's Buildings

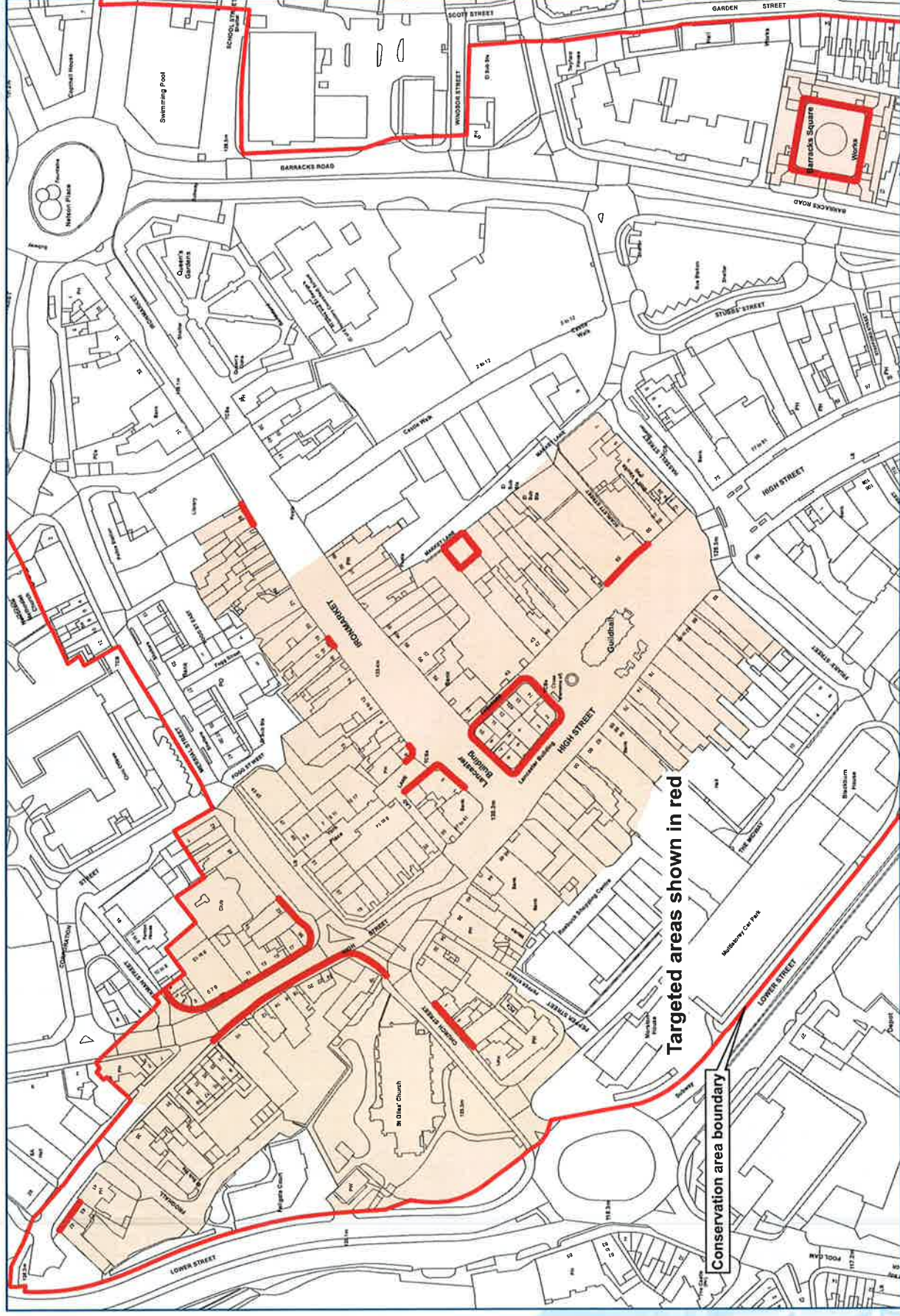
The council has joined forces with English Heritage and is offering grants to property owners within the town centre conservation area.

The scheme targets resources to historic properties to help preserve and enhance the town centre.

Grants of up to 50% and 60% may be available under the scheme for certain work.

Similar schemes in other towns have acted as a catalyst for wider change and regeneration.

Eligible Work

- Repairs to historic buildings.
- Putting back lost or damaged architectural features.
- Historic shopfront repairs or improvements.
- Modern shop fronts where appropriate*
- Small-scale works next to buildings such as alleyways.

* planning permission will be required for alterations

The scheme cannot fund:

- Works already started
- Demolitions
- Conversions
- Minor repairs and maintenance

Conservation-accredited professionals should be used for projects.
