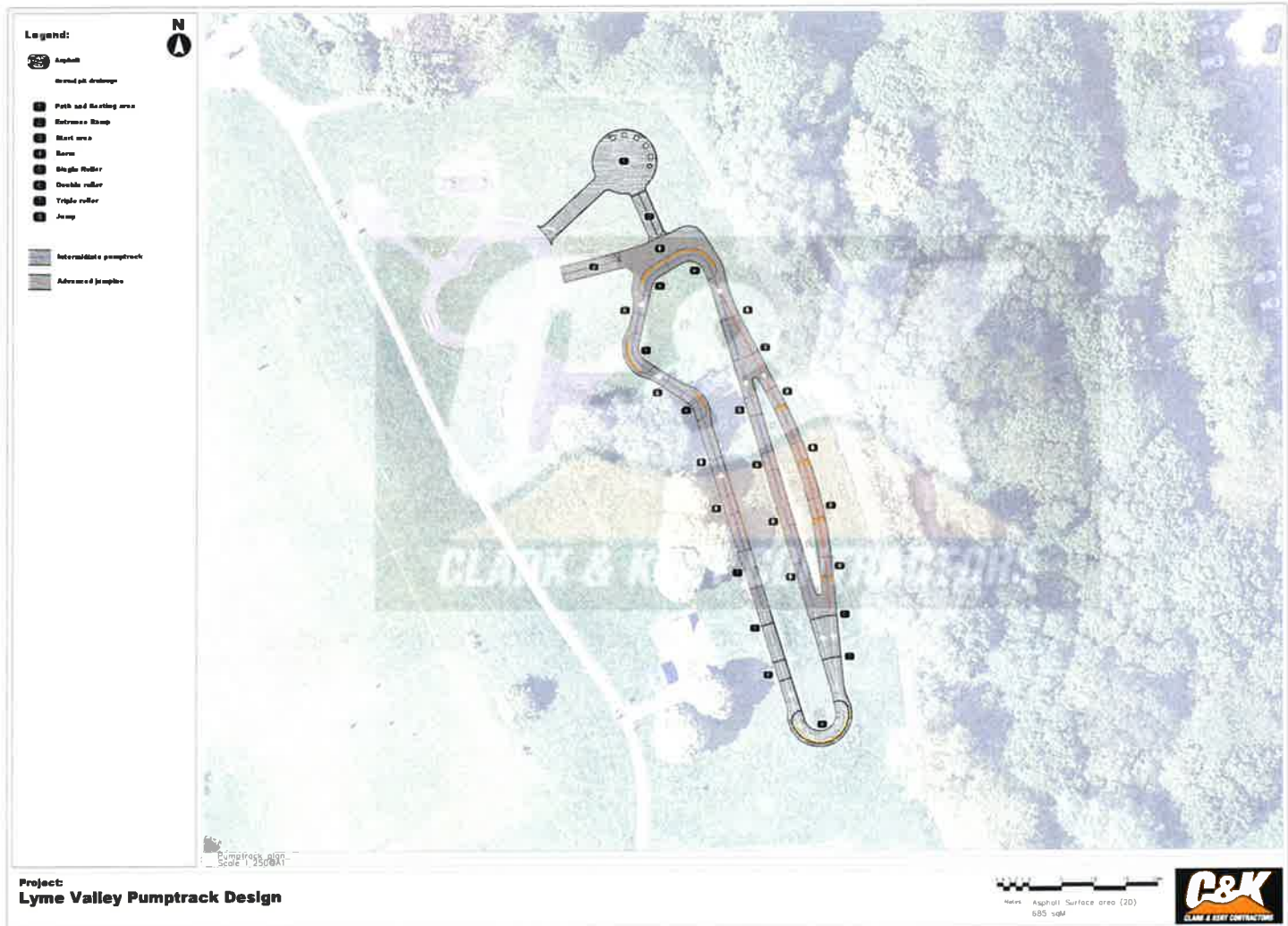


4. Design Proposal (35%)



Design Philosophy

The proposed pump track will be designed as a flowing, organic circuit that blends naturally into Lyme Valley Park. Largely utilising all of the existing footprint of the track along with using some of the space to the north of the existing track. Having grown up in and around the borough and using Lyme valley pump track when it was originally built we have a good understanding of the area, site access, user group and what it means for the local community.

Key objectives include:

- Suitable for beginners through to experienced riders
- Continuous riding without pedalling
- Inclusive layout
- Safe sight lines

- Natural landscaping integration
- Durable low-maintenance construction and low future on costs to the council
