<p>Land and Property</p>	<p>Any beneficial interest in land within the area of the council. <p>Licenses</p>	<p>Any licence you hold (alone or jointly with others) to occupy land in the area of the council for a month or longer. Typical examples include allotments, grazing land or domestic garages or storage units.</p>		
<p>Corporate Tenancies</p>	<p>Any tenancy where:- (a) the landlord is the council; and (b) the tenant is you or a partnership or incorporated body that you are a partner or a director* of or where you have a beneficial interest in the securities* of the incorporated body in question.</p>		

Securities	<p>Any beneficial interest in securities* of a body that has a place of business in the area of the council and <u>either</u>:-</p> <p>(a) the total nominal value of the securities* exceeds £25,000 or one hundredth of the total issued share capital of that body; or</p> <p>(b) if the share capital of that body is of more than one class, the total nominal value of the shares of any one class in which you have a beneficial interest exceeds one hundredth of the <u>total issued share capital of that class.</u></p>
